Prescott College Southern School Uniform Policy Last updated: March 2023



Rationale

A school uniform provides students with the opportunity to develop pride in their appearance while instilling a sense of belonging and helping them to recognise that they are an integral part of the school community and that they represent the school whenever they are wearing it.

Aims

- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To develop a sense of pride in, and identification with, the school.
- To provide cost effective clothing that is durable and practical for the school environment.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community.
- To prepare students for the world of work beyond school.

Implementation

- The Uniform Policy applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions and in public places.
- All students are expected to follow the school code of behaviour while wearing their uniform, whether they are on or off campus.
- Summer uniform is worn Terms 1 & 4. Winter uniform is worn Terms 2 & 3.
- There is a two-week period at the beginning of Terms 2 & 4 for the wearing of alternate uniforms dependent on the weather conditions.
 - Term 2 if temperature is forecast above 30 degrees full summer uniform can continue to be worn.
 - o Term 4 if the weather is below 20 degrees the full winter uniform can be worn.
- The Leadership Team, in conjunction with the teaching staff, will be responsible for implementation of the Uniform Policy consistent with the student code of conduct.

Summer Uniform - Terms 1 and 4

Female Students:

- School summer dress worn no shorter than the top of the knee cap or regulation blue short sleeve blouse with regulation navy shorts.
- White ankle socks worn with the top turned down.
- Regulation broad-brimmed hat to be worn at all times when outdoors.
- Black dress shoes with a heel, leather or vinyl, that are able to be polished and are lace up, buckle or velcro. The heel must be no more than 3cm in height.
- Brown or blue school sandals with a closed toe may be worn.
- Foundation to Year 6 students: Navy V-neck school jumper or school zip jacket or school woollen jumper or Year 6 graduation class jumper.
- Years 7 12 students: Regulation school blazer. If additional warmth required, school woollen
 jumper worn under blazer. The Graduation Jacket may be worn by Year 12 students with the
 school uniform at anytime

Male Students:

- School blue short-sleeved shirt.
- Regulation grey school shorts or long grey trousers.
- Grey school ankle socks with the top turned down.

- Regulation broad-brimmed hat to be worn at all times when outdoors.
- Black dress shoes with a heel, leather or vinyl, that are able to be polished and are lace up, buckle or velcro. The heel must be no more than 3cm in height.
- Foundation to Year 6 students: Navy V-neck school jumper or school zip jacket or school woollen jumper or Year 6 graduation class jumper.
- Years 7 12 students: Regulation school blazer. If additional warmth required, school woollen jumper worn under blazer. The Graduation Jacket may be worn by Year 12 students with the school uniform at anytime

Winter Uniform - Term 2 and 3

Female Students:

- Foundation to year 4 school pinafore or regulation navy trousers or shorts.
- Years 5 12 wear the regulation school skirt or regulation navy trousers or shorts.
- White long-sleeved school shirt or white short sleeved school shirt tucked in.
- Regulation school tie.
- White ankle socks with the top turned down. Students in Foundation to Year 6 may choose to wear navy tights and those in years 7-12 can wear black stockings.
- Black dress shoes with a heel, leather or vinyl, that are able to be polished and are lace up, buckled or velcro. The heel must be no more than 3cm in height.
- Foundation to Year 6 students: Navy V-neck school jumper or school zip jacket or the school woollen jumper or Year 6 graduation class jumper.
- Years 7 12 students: Regulation school blazer. If additional warmth required, school woollen jumper worn under blazer. The Graduation Jacket may be worn by Year 12 students with the school uniform at anytime
- Regulation broad-brimmed hat to be worn when the UVR level is predicted to be 3 or above on the day.

Male Students:

- White long-sleeved school shirt or white short sleeved school shirt tucked in.
- College grey school trousers or regulation summer shorts.
- School tie.
- Grey ankle socks with the top turned down.
- Black dress shoes with a heel, leather or vinyl, that are able to be polished and are lace up, buckle or velcro. The heel must be no more than 3cm in height.
- Foundation to Year 6 students: Navy V-neck school jumper or school zip jacket or school woollen jumper or Year 6 graduation class jumper.
- Years 7 12 students: Regulation school blazer. If additional warmth required, school woollen
 jumper worn under blazer. The Graduation Jacket may be worn by Year 12 students with the
 school uniform at anytime
- Regulation broad-brimmed hat to be worn when the UVR level is predicted to be 3 or above on the day.

School Blazers

- The school blazer is to be worn by secondary students at all formal school occasions during terms two and three. This includes when travelling to and from school, during homregroup time, at chapels and assemblies and on excursions.
- The blazer is not to be worn during practical lessons or sport related activities e.g. Technology, PE, recess and lunchtime games.

Physical Education

The PE uniform is to be worn on the nominated PE/sport days. For primary students, sports day is Thursday. The day varies for secondary students based on their individual timetable.

Primary School:

- Navy blue shorts, track pants (or skort for female students).
- Long or short sleeved navy polo shirt with logo.
- White sports socks.
- Recognised sneaker style sports shoes not casual canvas street/skate shoes.
- Foundation to year 6: Navy V-neck school jumper or school zip jacket with logo.
- Regulation broad-brimmed school hat.

Secondary School:

- School navy and maroon polo shirt.
- Navy monogrammed shorts or navy track pants.
- White sports socks.
- Sneaker style sports shoes not casual canvas street/skate shoes.
- Regulation broad-brimmed school hat.
- Navy sports jacket.

Please note that it is not appropriate for students to be wearing activewear with the school PE uniform.

Appearance

- Jewellery:
 - One pair of plain earrings only. eg. plain gold or silver sleepers or studs in the lobes of the ears only.
 - Other visible jewellery and body art is not permitted.
- Hair:
 - Students are expected to wear their hair in a manner that is neat, tidy, combed and clean.
 - Extreme cuts, colours and styles are not permitted for any students. Vibrant and unnatural colours are not acceptable. Any colour or style is to be blended and not be significantly contrasting.
 - The shortest haircut is to be done with a number 2 comb.
 - Students in Foundation to Year 9 are to have their hair tied up if it is longer than shoulder length. It needs to be tied back, off the face for students in years 10-12.
 - Navy blue, black or white hair ties, scrunchies, ribbons, headbands or small hair clips are acceptable.
 - Male students must be clean shaven.
- Cosmetics:
 - Students fingernails should be manicured to a length consistent with the requirements for playing sport. Clear nail polish may be worn, but false nails are not permitted.
 - Secondary students may wear light makeup that provides a natural appearance.
 - o No other make-up of any type is permitted.

Students Out of Uniform

Any student who does not meet the school's uniform and appearance requirements will be asked to correct the problem unless a parent or carer has provided a note of explanation. Parents and carers should discuss any issues with a Deputy Principal if their child will have difficulty meeting any of the above requirements for the long term. This includes exemptions to the policy based on religious and cultural beliefs, a diagnosed disability or economic hardship.

Items for resale that fit the criteria above must be dropped off at the uniform shop during the regular operating hours in a bag with the family name written on it. Any items left that are not suitable for resale, or have not sold within a reasonable length of time, may be donated to families in need or disposed of. Proceeds of the sale of second hand uniforms will be credited to the family via the student's fee account for all current students. There is a 30% handling fee for this service.
