

Fees for 2026

Summary of compulsory fees

The table below summarises the compulsory fees payable for each student.

Year Level	Annual Fee
Foundation to Year 6	\$5244
Year 7	\$5284
Year 8/9	\$7532
Year 10	\$7740
Year 11/12	\$8000

Included in the above are our levies for the building fund and IT services for all year levels.

Included in the relevant year levels above are levies for excursions and incursions (F-6 only), swimming and aquatics (F-9), textbook hire (7-12 only) and camps (8-12, excluding 11).

Discounts

The school fees are structured to assist families by offering a range of discounts. Please contact the school if you are unsure about your eligibility in any area.

Sibling Discount

Discounts on tuition fees for children attending Prescott College Southern are applied per child as follows:

- First child** - Full Fees
- Two children** - 15% discount
- Three children** - 30% discount
- Four children** - 40% discount
- Five or more children** - 50% discount



Camps and Activities Fees (Foundation to Year 7)

These fees are charged in addition to those in compulsory fees.

Prompt Payment Discount

A 3% discount is given if term fees are paid in full by week 2 of each term.

School Card Discount

Families that qualify for School Card can receive a 50% reduction on their annual tuition fee. This discount is provided based on the guidelines established by the Department for Education. To receive this, families must submit an application each year using the designated application forms.

External Students

Students can enrol in Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses or other subjects not offered at their school to earn credits for their South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE).

Here's how the costs work depending on the situation:

- 1. If a student takes a VET course in addition to their regular SACE subjects (meaning they are taking a full course load plus the VET course):**
 - The full cost of the VET course must be covered by the parent or caregiver.
- 2. For parents or caregivers enrolling their children in a VET certificate program:**
 - If the VET course fee exceeds **\$900**, the parent or caregiver pays the full amount to the course provider (like TAFE), then submits the invoice and proof of payment to the school. Once received, the school will apply a **\$900 credit** to the student's school fees.
 - If the course fee is **less than \$900**, the school will pay the entire amount. In this case, parents or caregivers will not receive any credit towards their school fees.

Split Fee Accounts

We recognise that family situations can differ greatly, and we are committed to handling each case with care and fairness. Typically, family accounts are billed based on the enrolment application. In the event of a separation, we ask that the enrolling parent or caregiver take responsibility for coordinating fee payments with the other parent or caregiver to ensure that all fees are kept up to date each term.

It's important to note that the school can only split accounts if there is a formal court order that specifies how the fees should be divided. We review each case individually and will collaborate with families to facilitate arrangements that comply with these guidelines.

Absences

Payment of school fees is still necessary even if a student is absent for any period.

If a student leaves the school for at least one term but wishes to return, they will need to pay a holding fee, which is at least 50% of the fees applicable during their absence.

Fee Payment Method

To provide families with greater flexibility, Prescott College Southern has partnered with **Edstart** to manage all school fees.

All families are required to set up an Edstart account via this link:

Through this secure portal, you have full control over how and when you pay your fees.

- **Flexible Instalments:** Spread your fees over the school year in weekly, fortnightly, or monthly instalments on a day that suits your budget.
- **Annual and Termly Payments:** You can also choose to pay your full annual or termly fees upfront through the portal.
- **No Extra Cost:** Using Edstart Plus is completely free for families. The College covers all transaction fees, though credit card payments attract a surcharge depending on the credit card issuer.
- **Simple Management:** You can adjust your payment method, dates, or amounts at any time via the online dashboard.

Debt Collection

Our college emphasises maintaining respectful relationships with parents and caregivers when it comes to managing tuition fees. We are dedicated to working with families to create payment plans that align with their financial situations. Effective communication is vital for addressing any changes that may occur.

If families do not respond to our attempts to collect fees, we may need to involve a debt collection service, and any associated costs will be the family's responsibility, as stated in the enrollment application. It's also important to note that all individuals who signed the agreement are jointly responsible for the tuition fees, regardless of any changes in their relationship status.
